The airline is upgrading all its seats of their domestic fleet, more than 50 aircrafts, with lightweight leather made by WOLLSDORF LEATHER!

Good news from WOLLSDORF LEATHER in the field of aircraft leather. The Company has received an upcharge from JAPAN AIRLINES (JAL) to equip all seats of the B737, B767 and B777 of the Domestic Fleet – that is all machines that are used within Japan (a total of more than 50 aircraft) – with the Light Leather "Amba Eco" developed by WOLLSDORF LEATHER. This concerns the Economy, Premium Economy as well as the First Class seats.

"We are particularly pleased to be awarded this contract by JAL," says the managing director of WOLLSDORF LEATHER, Andreas Kindermann. "It is the first major contract in the area of airplane lightweight leather in Japan, which we were able to get together with our longtime partners Rohi," he continues.

For JAL, the savings of this investment are not insignificant. The weight of the leather is reduced by more than a third over the standard leather.
