WOLLSDORF LEATHER

Realignment for the future!

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The actual state

WOLLSDORF LEATHER, as a strong export-oriented enterprise, always has to adapt to the market needs of its international customers.

This is true especially for the company's depth of production and location of sites.

So in addition to focusing on the production of leather, more and more leather parts are prefabricated for a wide variety of clients at WOLLSDORF LEATHER. This takes place both in the Far East, at the new plant in China, and at the stamping factory in the neighboring town called Weiz.

Now the opportunity for growth due to the local conditions in Weiz is already exhausted and WOLLSDORF LEATHER can no further expand, although it is demanded by the market.

The logical consequence

Due to the present situation, the company has been looking for a location that corresponds to the current needs on one hand, and also provides an ideal potential for future growth on the other hand. This is very important for the company.

A building site was found near the renowned town of Varazdin in Croatia, located on the axis between the Site WOLLSDORF and some major customers in Romania, an approximately 2 hour drive from the headquarters in WOLLSDORF.

The new plant will start production in September 2014.

What does that mean for the stamping plant in Weiz

As mentioned above, as of September 2014, the production in Croatia will start up with new customer orders that will be processed in the factory of Varazdin.

Existing orders are still being processed in Weiz until June 2015. Of the currently 240 employees, who work in the stamping plant in Weiz, about 100 employees will find employment again at the main plant in WOLLSDORF.

Thus, for example, the process of "Marking" the leather (ie leather parts, which are not suitable for the further production) moved from Weiz to WOLLSDORF.
